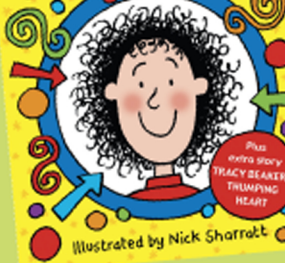

You'll Need

- ★ Card
- ★ Glue
- ★ 2 paper fasteners
- ★ Old biscuit box
- ★ Wrapping paper

1. Stick this page to card and cut out the Tracy shapes.

2. Measure 11cm from the bottom of the box and draw a line all the way round. Cut off anything above the line and cover the box with wrapping paper.

3. Cut two small strips of card and push a paper fastener through the centre of each one. Stick a Tracy on top of each strip, covering the paper fastener.

4. Loosely fasten a Tracy to the front and back of the box. Pop in your pencils and make Tracy spin!
