5: Joining	Alternative forms: 'e' and 's'	When joining, the letters 'e' and 's' often take a different form when in the middle of a word. This introduces the alternative style.
	End-low diagonal joins: 'ch', 'sh', 'th', 'qu', 'ck', 'ai', 'air', 'er', 'soft 'g'	Joins are introduced in one-by-one encouraging children to end the letter and continue to the start of the next letter. Supported by animations on the CD-ROM.
	End-low drop-on joins: 'ed', 'ng', 'ear', 'igh'	
	End-high horizontal joins: 'or', 'oi', 'ow'	
	End-high diagonal joins: 'wh', 'ot', 'rk'	
	End-high drop-on joins: 'oo', 'oa', 'wa'	
	End-high to 'e': 'oe', 're'	End-high to 'e' is an end-high drop-on join but is given its own section as it is a tricky join. Supported by animations on the CD-ROM.
Tricky joins: 'ss', 'ff', 'ee', 'zz'	Other tricky joins: where a second-style of a letter is used, it is a difficult movement or an unusual letter combination. Supported by animations on the CD-ROM.
