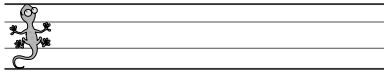


Transforming verbs to nouns

- Change the bold verbs into nouns. Be careful! Some of the root words' spellings change.

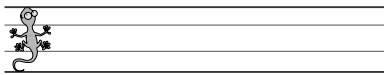

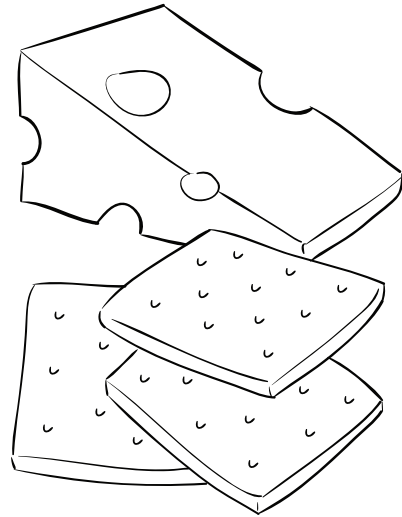
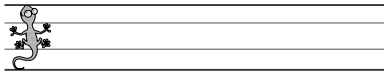
