27	<p>Award 1 mark for answers such as: <i>It tells us he wishes they didn't exist now.</i> <i>He thinks they are a very bad thing.</i></p>	1	AF4
28	<p>a) Award 1 mark for either: <i>Off the coast of Somalia or</i> <i>In Somalia</i></p> <p>b) Award 1 mark for answers which infer reasons from the text such as: <i>Somalia is a poor country.</i> <i>The pirates used to be fishermen but cannot fish any longer.</i></p>	1	AF2
