## Factors

A factor is a number which, when multiplied with another number, produces a whole number.

For example, 5 and 6 are factors of 30 . So are 3 and 10 .
$5 \times 6=30$ and $3 \times 10=300$.
Any number that goes exactly into 30 will be a factor of 30 .
