## Follow-up activities

## Break it up

• Invite the children to extend the poem or rewrite it so that every question becomes a verse or even a poem in its own right. Challenge them to think about details that can be added to make the poem more interesting.

## A day in the life

- Let the children create a new poem based on the adventures of their creature. For example:
  - The Day the Creature Ate the Homework
  - The Day the Monster Burped in Class
  - When the Creature Frightened Our Teacher
