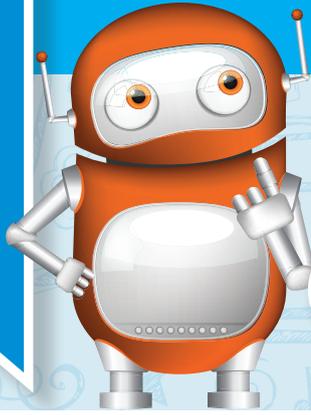


Features of text



What are features of texts?

heading and bold text

A *whirlpool of emotion* splashed tears into Sara's eyes. Why did it have to happen

italics

now? Things had been going *like clockwork*.

simile

Lewis wasn't meant to get that text. It was stupid. **Stupid, stupid, stupid!**

repetition
