

# ANIMAL JAM ACADEMY

Use the sun to create your own unique masterpiece.



## WHAT TO DO:

1. Collect some objects to make prints with, like leaves, branches or other items you might find in your home or garden.
2. Find a spot outside that is in the sun for at least four hours.
3. Set up the paper in the sunny spot and place the objects you want in your print on the paper.
4. Cover with the pane of glass or small rocks to hold the objects in place.
5. Wait for six hours, then check your print. Remove the objects and check out the picture you've created.

## WHAT YOU NEED:

- black construction paper
- leaves, sticks or other objects
- a pane of glass (from a picture frame) or some small rocks

## HOW YOU DID IT!

The picture was created because the sun's UV rays discolour the paper. Even though the sun is 150 million km away, it only takes 8 minutes for the light of the sun to reach Earth.

Create some cool bracelets with this simple craft.

## WHAT YOU NEED:

- large craft sticks
- bowl
- hot water
- a mug or glass
- string, thread
- tape



## WHAT TO DO:

1. Soak your craft sticks in a bowl of hot water until they are soft enough to bend.
2. Bend your sticks into a c-shape by placing them inside a mug or glass.
3. Let the craft sticks dry out inside the mug or glass overnight.
4. Remove the craft sticks, which are now a bracelet shape and decorate using coloured tape and threads.
5. You can wear them as a cuff or ask an adult to make small holes in each of their ends to thread some string through as a fastener.



You could make lots of bracelets and give them to your friends!
