Sid saw a light in the sky.

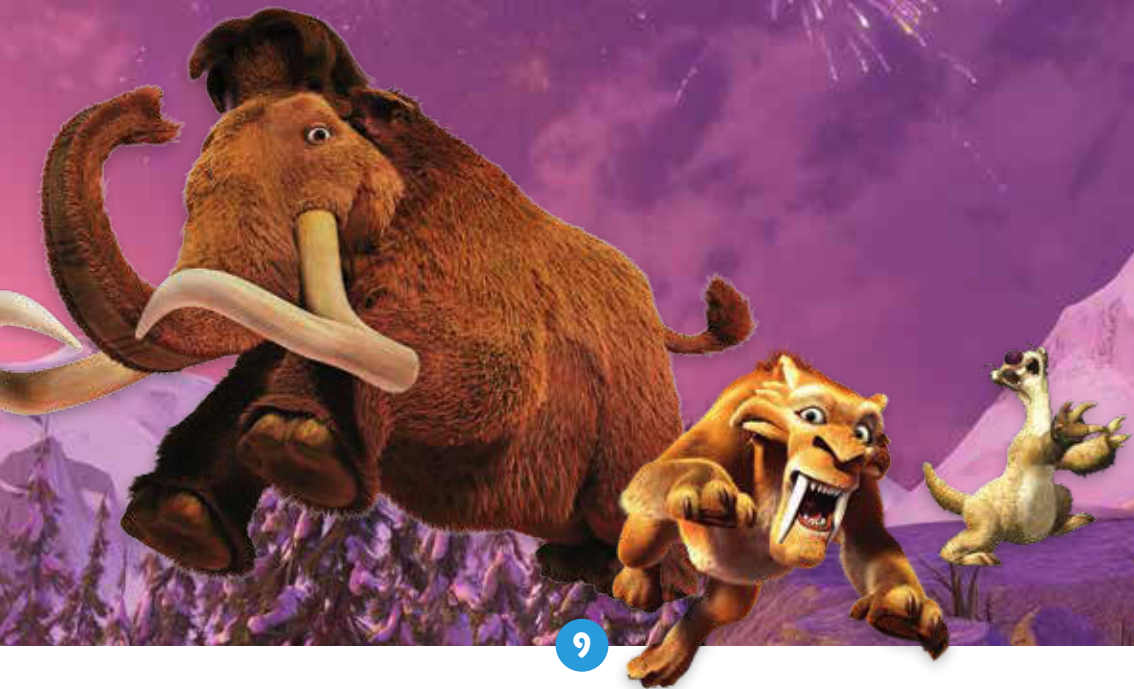
'Look!' said Sid. 'It's coming down.'
