## How to use this book



This book contains four different sets of maths tests for Year 6, each containing SATs-style questions. Each set comprises one arithmetic test and two reasoning tests, worth 28 marks in total. As a whole, the complete set of tests provides full coverage of the test framework for this age group, across the two strands of the maths curriculum: Number; and Measurement, geometry and statistics.

Some questions require a selected response, for example where children choose the correct answer from several options. Other questions require a constructed response, where children work out and write down their own answer.

A mark scheme, skills check and progress chart are also included towards the end of this book.

#### Completing the tests


- It is intended that children will take approximately ten minutes to complete each individual test; or approximately 30 minutes to complete each set of three tests.


