## What you need to know

- Selected questions don't ask you to write an answer. For these questions, you need to circle, tick or draw lines.
- The question will usually tell you how many things to tick or circle.
- You need to make your answers clear. If you tick too many answers you may not be given the mark. Make sure that you cross out any changes clearly.
- Read the questions carefully to check for distractors.
