<b>Grammar and punctuation essentials:</b> An exclamation sentence starts with 'How' or 'What', contains a verb and ends with an exclamation mark. A statement tells you something and ends with a full stop. A question is a sentence that asks something and ends with a question mark.																		
4	<b>Award 1 mark</b> for: 'We take the bus to school. Sometimes Dad drives us there in the car.' <b>Punctuation essentials:</b> A statement ends with a full stop.	1																
5	<b>Award 1 mark</b> if 'my' and 'london' are circled. <b>Punctuation essentials:</b> A sentence starts with a capital letter. Names of places also start with a capital letter.	1																
6	<b>Award 1 mark</b> if 'est' is ticked. <b>Grammar essentials:</b> The suffixes 'est', 'ed' and 'ing' can be added to some verbs and adjectives. Sometimes, we may need to change the spelling of the root word, for example: happy, happiest.	1
