## Dear Helper

This activity is designed to help your child to work out the change from 20p for different prices. If your child finds this difficult, use real money: ask them to find the change by picking up coins. For example, for a price of 8 p, 2 p more makes 10 p and 10 p more makes 20 p. So the change is $12 p$. Alternatively, your child could count up in pennies, then change these for the smallest possible number of coins. If your child has completed the activity, challenge them to find the change from 20p for two stickers.
