### Dear Helper

This activity helps your child to round large numbers and use rounding to estimate. Estimating is a good skill to use in maths. When doing the additions, encourage your child to estimate first, then calculate, and then to check their answers. Look for some large numbers in newspapers and do the same exercise. Attendances at football matches are a good example. Ask, for example: *Roughly how many people attended the United match and the Arsenal match altogether?*
