
Learn punctuation with Frank the Full Stop!

Full stop



Used to end a sentence.

Comma

Used to continue a sentence, like this, when there is more to say.

Question mark



Isn't it used to ask a question?

Exclamation mark



Used to end a sentence with excitement!

Ellipsis



Used to show when something is unfinished...

Speech marks



"These show when someone is talking," I said.

Apostrophe



Used to show when something's shortened or if it's yours.

Colon





Used to: introduce lists, introduce explanations, and separate a sentence.

Semi-colon



A semi-colon is used rarely; it is used to separate related sentences.
