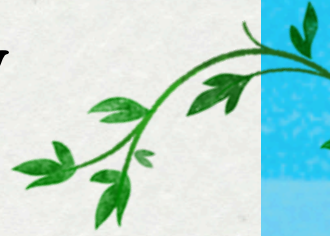


Murder at the Ivy Hotel by Emily Hourican Discussion Questions

3. The book alternates between Meredith and Macy's perspectives. Which one did you enjoy reading the most and why?
4. Throughout the book, Meredith and Macy develop a friendship with their neighbour, Colin. What qualities do you think make a good friend?
5. The story takes place in the old and beautiful Ivy Hotel in Dublin. In what ways did this setting add to the mystery of the story?
6. Mystery books can sometimes contain red herrings, which are false clues designed to mislead readers. Did you spot any red herrings whilst reading? What were they?
7. What was your favourite moment from the book and why?
8. What did you think of the ending? Did you solve the mystery or was the reveal a surprise?
9. Which character from *Murder at the Ivy Hotel* would you choose as your detective partner and why?
10. If you had to describe the book in three words to a friend, what would they be?
