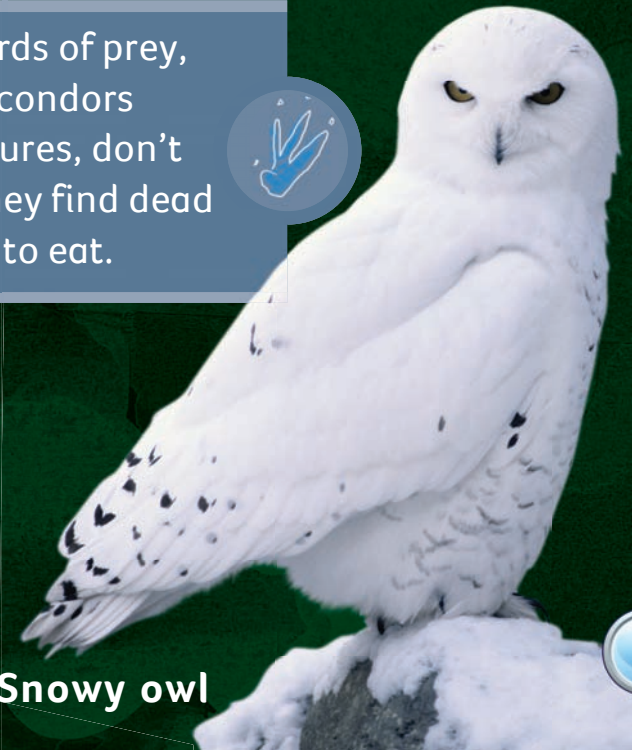

Hawk	Eagle	Falcon	Owl
Prey: mice, rats, squirrels, chipmunks, snakes, fish, other birds	Prey: fish, rabbits, sloths, monkeys, young antelopes, small birds	Prey: hares, mice, lizards, lemmings, insects, other birds	Prey: mice, rats, voles, squirrels, rabbits, other birds
Special feature: they have very good eyesight. They can see animals from 30 metres high in the sky.	Special feature: they are the largest hunting birds of prey. A harpy eagle can snatch a monkey from the treetops.	Special feature: they dive at great speed to catch their prey. Some can even fly upside down.	Special feature: Most owls hunt at night. They have big eyes, good hearing, and soft feathers for silent flight.

Some birds of prey, such as condors and vultures, don't hunt. They find dead animals to eat.
