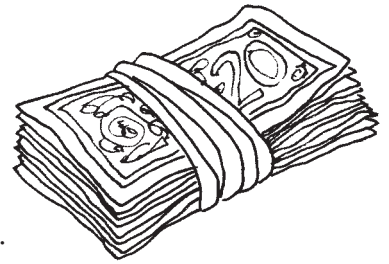


Chain of consequences
