1. Who warned Kasper not to move? (1 mark)
2. Do you think that Jingo's friend Knucklehead was careless? Why do you say that? (2 marks)
3. Why do you think that Kasper didn't want to move around in the kitchen? How do you know that? (2 marks)
4. Do you think that the dogs are dangerous? Why do you say that? (2 marks)
5. Do you think that Kasper had visited Jingo and Knucklehead before? How do you know that? (2 marks)
6. Give three reasons why you think the dogs are so aggressive. (3 marks)
