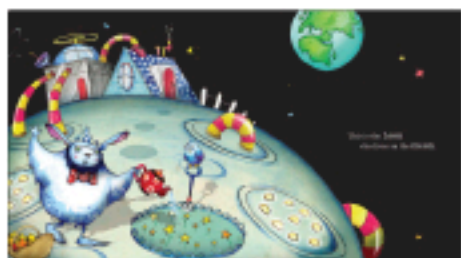
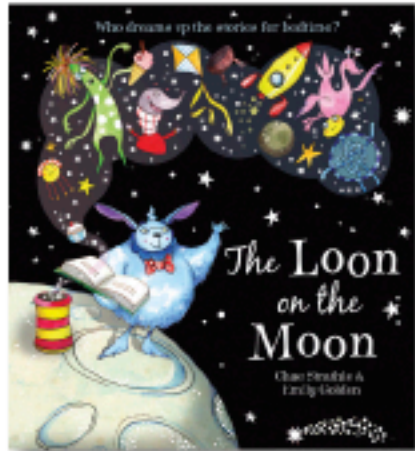




The Loon on the Moon

Describe where you live. Can you draw a picture of your house?



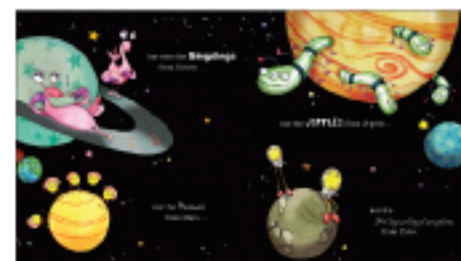
Every night the Loon collects dream steam while the children sleep.
